MS Nordstjernen Travel Itinerary*

Day 1: Embarkation in Warnemünde

Your adventure begins in the picturesque port town of Warnemünde. Learn to know the MS Nordstjernen and relax on the cozy lounge deck. Enjoy the the departure from the Warnow river and prepare for the exciting days ahead.

Day 2: Rønne (Bornholm)

The Danish island of Bornholm welcomes you with its unique blend of history and nature. In Rønne, the island's largest town, you'll find cobblestone streets, traditional half-timbered houses, and the impressive Hammershus Fortress.

Day 3: Gdańsk (Danzig)

Welcome to one of Poland's most beautiful cities! Gdańsk delights with its magnificent Old Town, lovingly reconstructed after World War II. Stroll along the famous Long Market, admire the iconic Crane Gate, and experience the stunning St. Mary's Church. The city's harbor tells tales of trade and the Hanseatic League, shaping Baltic life for centuries.

Day 4: Klaipėda

Lithuania's oldest city, Klaipėda, offers a special charm with its historic center and famous half-timbered buildings. The port opens the door to the Curonian Spit, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its unique dune landscapes.

This Latvian port city captivates with its clean streets and lovingly restored buildings. The city's landmark, the 13th-century Livonian Order Castle, tells the story of the region's rich history. The wide beach invites you to a relaxing stroll.

Day 6: Riga

The Latvian capital, Riga, is a true gem of Art Nouveau architecture, boasting one of Europe's most beautiful Old Towns. In its charming streets, you'll feel the pulse of this vibrant metropolis that masterfully blends tradition and modernity.

Day 7: Pärnu

Estonia's "summer capital" Pärnu attracts with its long sandy beaches and maritime charm. The historic Old Town enchants with colorful buildings and cozy cafés. The Elisabeth Church, one of the city's oldest structures, is particularly impressive.

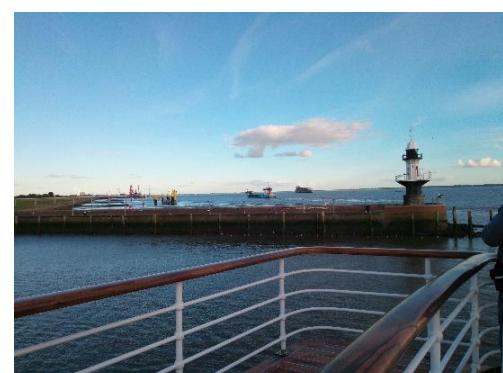
Day 8: Saaremaa
