MS Nordstjernen Travel Itinerary*

Day 1: Embarkation in Bergen

Your journey begins in Bergen, known for the famous Bryggen district, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The colorful wooden facades tell of the city's long Hanseatic history. Go onboard the MS Nordstjernen in the afternoon and relax on the lounge deck as the ship remains docked overnight.
